ZCB Won Prestigious International Environmental Award

Hong Kong · 31 July 2015 – ZCB has won the National Energy Globe Award Hong Kong 2015, an international environmental award, from the Austria-based Energy Globe Foundation. The award ceremony was held on Friday, 31 July 2015 at ZCB in Kowloon Bay. Mr. Christian H. SCHIERER, Consul, Head of ADVANTAGE AUSTRIA and Regional Trade Commissioner presented the Award to Chairman LEE Shing-see of the Construction Industry Council. The Hon. WONG Kam-sing, Secretary for the Environment, attended as the Guest of Honour.

The Energy Globe is one of today's most important environmental awards with 177 participating countries and annually more than 1,500 project entries. It recognises resource-conservation projects regionally, nationally, and globally. It aims to promote awareness and application of sustainable and innovative environmental solutions.

ZCB is Hong Kong's first zero carbon building. It showcases over 80 eco technologies that harness renewable energy or boost energy efficiency. Its landscaped area features an urban native woodland that absorbs carbon dioxide. ZCB is an exhibition, education, and outreach facility, as well as a public park. With its innovative building design and advanced eco technologies, ZCB has been chosen as the national winner of Hong Kong this year. "This award is a great recognition of our work to promote zero carbon buildings to the construction industry and low carbon living to the community," Chairman LEE said.

This is the fifteenth recognitions/awards ZCB has won for its innovation and environmental performance since its inauguration in 2012. The ZCB has so far welcomed approximately 40,000 visitors from Hong Kong and abroad.
